

AN ORDINANCE

To Establish in Beaufort County a Central County Sanitary Landfill System, to Set Forth Provisions under which it will be Operated and to Provide a Penalty for Violators of this Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the County Council of Beaufort County in a meeting duly assembled and through authority granted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina; Establish a central county sanitary landfill system, set-forth provisions under which it will be operated, and provide a penalty for violators of this ordinance.

SECTION I. Such sanitary landfill will be for disposal of specified solid waste from the County of Beaufort.

SECTION II. All other landfills heretofore operated in the County of Beaufort will cease operations and be closed to all dumping of waste of any description. From time to time other areas may be designated for disposal of farm waste.

SECTION III. Operations and rules governing the use of the central landfill area will be set by County Council and carried out under direct authority and supervision of the Beaufort County Supervisor, and/or a Sanitation Department which may be established by County Council.

SECTION IV. Rates for use of the landfill area will be established by County Council on a load or tonnage basis and will be amended from time to time as necessary. All funds generated shall accrue to General Fund of Beaufort County.

SECTION V. Copies of such rates and rules and regulations will be provided at all times at the site of such sanitary landfill.


SECTION VI. Such sanitary landfill will be operated in compliance with regulations and standards required by the South Carolina Pollution Control Authority.


SECTION VII. Violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or any of the rules and regulations set by County Council governing solid waste disposal and use of the sanitary landfill area will be deemed a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or Thirty (30) Days in jail or both in the discretion of the court. A violation of this Ordinance shall not be considered as a continuing offense, but each day that this Ordinance is violated shall be a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION VIII. This Ordinance shall be effective August 16, 1971 after approval by the County Council of Beaufort County and after the prescribed publication.
