

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the intersection of Buckingham Plantation Drive and Moss Creek Drive on U.S. Highway 278 in Bluffton Township will experience increasing traffic and heightened citizen concern for public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Bluffton Township Fire District will occupy a new fire station off U.S. Highway 278 at this intersection in the Summer 1993 and will use this intersection when responding to fire and EMS calls; and

WHEREAS, Old South Golf Course is in full operation and growing; other small businesses are now planned or under construction that will use this intersection to exit and enter U.S. Highway 278; and

WHEREAS, a planned unit development off Buckingham Plantation Drive is currently in the approval process that will develop some 314 acres yielding a potential build out of 498 family units the traffic from which will use this identical intersection; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing conditions argue for effective measures to enhance and ensure safe and efficient traffic flow at this intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Beaufort County Council supports efforts to place full traffic signalization at the site where Buckingham Plantation Drive and Moss Creek Drive intersect U.S. Highway 278 and respectfully request the S.C. Department of Highways and Public Transportation give favorable consideration and support to this request.
